Signature Center is New York City's newest cultural destination and provides an interactive experience for families, communities, and groups of all sizes. Just a few blocks west of Times Square, our Frank Gehry-designed Signature Center houses three intimate Off-Broadway theatres connected by a large lobby, a café, bookstore, and several digital storytelling panels where visitors can interact and learn more about our history.

## Frequently Asked Questions

### **How many people do I need to qualify as a group?**

A group is a sale of 10 or more tickets on the same night paid with one check or credit card.

### **How much are tickets to a Signature Theatre Company performance?**

During a show's regularly scheduled run, all ticket prices are \$25.

### **Do I get a discount if I book a group to attend one of your performances?**

Due to the Signature Ticket Initiative, we are not able to offer discounts to groups during the originally scheduled run of our shows. If one of our shows extends, a discount may be offered. However, the ticket fee is waived for all group ticket purchases (\$4.50/per ticket).

### **When is payment due? Is a deposit required?**

Payment must be made in full 6 weeks prior to the performance date, if a reservation is made less than six weeks before a performance date, payment must be submitted within 3 business days of the reservation. A 25% deposit must be made with groups larger than 40 people.

### **Will my group be seated together?**

We will try our best to accommodate your seating preferences. Due to the intimate nature of our theatres, having large groups sit together is not always possible.

### **How do I get my tickets?**

Tickets can be picked up at the Box Office one hour prior to the performance. **Please designate a Group Leader to pick up all tickets and have them distribute tickets to your group.** Signature Center is located at 480 West 42<sup>nd</sup> Street, New York, NY, between Dyer and 10<sup>th</sup> Avenues.

### **I'm from out of town. Where can we eat or drink in the neighborhood?**

Signature Center offers a full service bar and café in our Frank Gehry designed center. Enjoy a cocktail, meal, or snack before or after the performance without worrying about rushing to the theater to be on time for a performance.

### **Where can I park near Signature Center?**

Park & Lock, 42<sup>nd</sup> Street between 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> Avenues.

### **How can I take public transportation to Signature Center?**

Take the A, C, E to 42<sup>nd</sup> Street, walk 3 blocks west or transfer to the M42 bus to 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue or take any train to 42<sup>nd</sup> Street/Times Square and transfer to the M42 bus to 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Please note that it takes a couple of minutes to walk to the Signature Center from the subway, so please plan accordingly.

### **We are coming from out of town, any recommendations for hotels or lodging in the area?**

Signature Center offers a variety of supplemental programming for all audiences. Programming for the 2012 Season may include:

- Post-show Talkback Series
- Page to Stage: A moderated conversation between the playwright and director
- The World of the Play: A discussion on a topic or theme related to one of our productions with a team of experts from the field
- The Art of Collaboration: A talk between one of our Playwrights-in-Residence and their closest artistic collaborators
- Meet the Playwrights-in-Residence: A moderated panel discussion with our Residency One, Residency Five, and Legacy Program playwrights
- Page to Stage: A pre- or post-show conversation with the playwright and director
- Signature Book Club, Alumni Performance Series, Film Screenings, Conversations with STC Staff.
